In the event that a job camping site can't be provided, you will be directed to the nearest RV park.

Responsibilities include:

- Driving a belly/side/dump truck on jobs as directed.
- Maintain compliance with all FMCSA regulations.
- Conduct pre-trip and post-trip inspections
- Communicating with management and field personnel.

Qualifications:

- 100 hours previous experience driving a belly/side/dump truck is preferred.
- Ability to drive in inclement weather; chaining up as necessary.
- Effective communicator, verbally and electronically.
- Class A commercial license with DBL/TRI and tanker endorsements is preferred.
- Have an acceptable motor vehicle driving history.
- Drivers MUST complete a pre-employment DOT drug test before employment.
